However, when we understand that we must all be tested at one time or the other, our perspective on the challenges of life will change to one that pleases God. A way that pleases God is the way Job responded when he was told that all his children has perished and all cattle lost.

"... the Lord gave and the Lord taken away: blessed be

the name of the Lord" *(Job 1:21)* Or when his wife, was unable to bear the suffering asked Job to curse God and die. Job responded.

"... you speak as one the foolish women speak, shall we receive good at the hand of God and shall not receive evil? (Job 2:10) Our lives however sweet, sometimes have the sour part of it. It may be that you are on the sick bed right now, or probably experiencing a disappointment that has destabilized you: it may be that there is something you are expecting from God that you have not got; or perhaps your business is not in good shape; or may be things have turned upside down in your life and you are questioning yourself WHY ME? Will you take it as an examination! You see, one thing about examination is that you are either promoted, asked to repeat or withdraw. I know that it is not easy to trust God when things are right in our lives but I have known from personal experience that God loves us too much to allow anything that will not result ultimately for our own good to happen to us. Beyond the dark clouds, there is always a silver lining. If you look at problems from the proper perspective, you will disappoint Satan and please God .i.e say like Job "... though he slay me ,yet will l trust in Him." (Job 13:15)

...when he hath tried me, I shall forth as Gold " *(Job 23:10)*
